Telehealth can help with reports, evaluations, and therapeutic services.

- Because there is no need for travel time or distance, therapy hours can be extended.
- Telehealth can provide services that accommodate your schedule and other obligations; therapy can be conducted in the convenience of your home or at a preferred location.

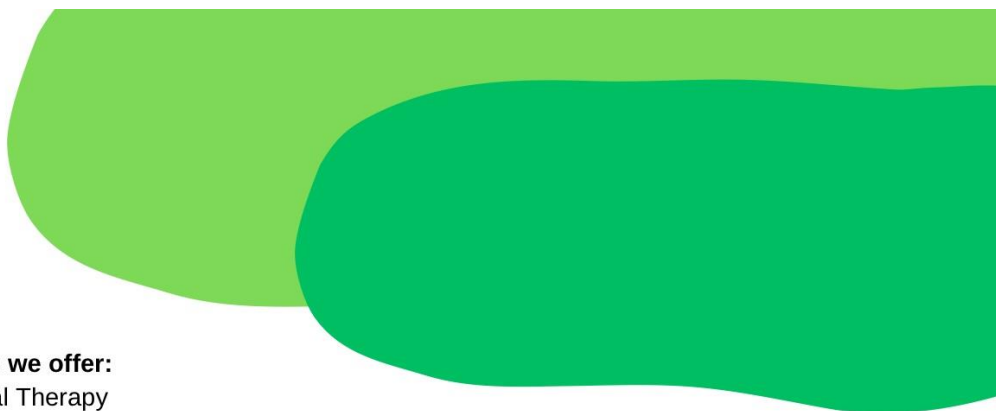
How to access telehealth?
